

What will your New Year's Resolution Be? Make a Difference...Be A Mentor!

The district's Spring Board Mentor Program brings caring adult role models into our school once a week, to spend 30 - 45 minutes (typically during Advisory on Thursday mornings or at lunch) as a role model, advocate and friend to a student "on the brink of success." Mentors are asked to commit to a school year timeframe, and over 90% of our Mentors return to our program each year, following their student as they grow through the grade levels.

Students self-select for the program, and parents grant permission for them to participate. Data indicates that 95% of students with a Mentor see themselves as more focused on school and they are more happy, well adjusted and skilled socially and emotionally. There are many students at SBMS that have requested to have a Mentor and we currently have 17 kids on the waiting list! We hope you will consider this opportunity and mention it to your neighbors, parents, and friends.
