

## Spring Forest Lunch Schedule on STAAR Test Administration Days (Local/State)



**On all STAAR Test Days, 6<sup>th</sup> & 7<sup>th</sup> grade students may bring a sack lunch or order a sack lunch through the cafeteria.**

This arrangement has several advantages and is deemed necessary considering the STAAR test administration will run through the regular 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> grade lunch schedules.

- ✓ Students have an uninterrupted testing environment—they get to remain in their testing room.

**Please Note:** Because of STAAR testing restrictions, NO outside or parent deliveries are allowed on test days for any students.

### Lunch Procedures

**8<sup>th</sup> graders will eat lunch in the cafeteria at their regular scheduled lunch time on all test days.**

**LUNCH 1:09 PM – 1:39 P.M.**

- **6<sup>th</sup> & 7<sup>th</sup> grade students will eat lunch in their designated testing room on all test days, unless all (grade level) students are complete with the assessment. If this occurs, we will revert back to the normal or altered test day schedule. This will only occur on local assessment days. On state test days we will remain in testing mode throughout the duration of the four-hour testing period.**
- **Thus, 6<sup>th</sup> & 7<sup>th</sup> grade students have two options:**

– Bring a sack lunch from home on all test days. (Students bringing a sack lunch from home must have them when they arrive to school and take it with them to their testing room.)

– Order a sack lunch from the cafeteria on all test days through the testing room supervisor.

- Ordering—the cost will be deducted from the student's lunch account.
- Students already on the free/reduced lunch program must order a lunch utilizing the lunch count form provided by the testing administrator.
- **Absolutely no outside or parent deliveries are allowed on test days.**
