**COURSE DESCRIPTION**

**\*BEGINNING COMPUTERS** - Learn all you need to get the most out of your computing experience, from basic computer operation to exploring the internet and e-mail. We will start with basic customization of your computer, how to find things you have added or deleted. We will learn how to safely remove programs, basic internet usage and safety. Prerequisite: No Experience Necessary. This is a beginning level class. (Limit 14)

**\*BELLY DANCING** - For fun and exercise. This is a very casual and low stress class. Please wear comfortable, loose fitting clothes and bare feet. Plan to have fun while exercising!

**\*CERAMICS (BEGINNING/INTERMEDIATE & ADVANCED)** - This class is designed for both those with little or now ceramic experience BUT who want to expand their knowledge or refresh their skill as well as those with some proficiency who want to increase their technical skills. This course will take students through centering, maximizing volume, trimming, glazing techniques and studio safety. Students will create beautiful vases, masks, and sculptural forms. \$40.00 materials fee payable to teacher. (Limit 10)

**\*COMPUTACIÓN BÁSICA** - Este curso enseñara a los estudiantes principiantes habilidades de informática muy básicas. Se centrará en las partes principales de una computadora, el teclado, el uso del ratón y convertir un ordenador encendido y apagado. También aprenderá vocabulario ordenador. También vamos a mostrar fácil que esc rear una cuenta de correo electrónico, enviar e-mails y abrir, enviar y guardar archivos adjuntos (require que tenga una cuenta de email), spam, etc. Usted también aprenderá el propósito de el Internet. También explica la World Wide Web y cómo realizar búsquedas y transacciones. Ir mas allá de la búsqueda de base de Internet y ver qué más se puede hacer con Google. Este curso es ideal para las personas con poca o ninguna experiencia en computadoras. (Duracion son ocho (8) semanas y se limite 14 estudiantes)

**\*ENGLISH AS A SECOND LANGUAGE (E.S.L.)** - For the non-English speaker or those who want to improve their English. (Four levels: Beginner, Intermediate, Advanced & Advanced Conversation)

**\*FOOD & NUTRITION EDUCATION** - This Expanded Food and Nutrition Education program will include everything from Healthy Food/Healthy Families, Making the Most of MyPlate, Setting your Limits, Mealtime Miracles and more. There will also be in class food demonstrations. You will receive a Certificate of Completion from Texas A&M Agrilife at the end of program.

**\*G.E.D. PREPARATION (English & Spanish)**-Covers all five areas you will be tested on when you take the G.E.D. Test. (G.E.D. testing not done at this location, we only prepare you for the test.)

**\*PREPARING FOR CITIZENSHIP** - This class is designed to prepare beginning and intermediate level adults students for the naturalization process. *Prerequisite:* Must have completed Intermediate E.S.L.

**\*QUILTING CLUB** - This is a student-directed Quilting Club. No Teacher or instruction provided. This is not your grandmother's quilt, but she would have loved it! Come and make a heirloom quilt and join the fun. Suitable for ALL EXPERIENCED QUILTERS. This is a FUN, progress-at-your-own-pace class.

**\*SEWING** - Students will learn how to use a sewing machine and select patterns based on their measurements. They will learn about different fibers/fabric construction and how to select suitable fabrics for projects. Students will learn various techniques and sewing skills. Students will be charged a \$1 bobbin fee payable to the instructor. Note: 2nd hour of the first class will be spent at a local fabric store. (Limit 12)

**\*SPANISH I** - Students will learn the sounds of the language as spoken mainly in the United States. Grammar covered will be the use of the three basic verb groups -AR, -ER and -IR verbs, Irregular verbs and Stem-Changing verbs in the Present Tense. Several irregular verbs: ser, estar, & gustar will be presented. Other areas covers will include: nouns, articles and adjectives. (Textbook \$20.00)

**\*SPANISH II** - Students will review Spanish I. Focus remains on a combination of reading, writing, listening and speaking. Grammar will continue in the present tense verb usage. Additional study of different types of adjectives and other grammatical discussion will continue. It also covers: numbers, days, months, dates, expressing time and a more advanced coverage of adjectives.

**\*TREASURE HUNTERS** - In this class, we will periodically travel to estate/garage sales and or resale shops to discover hidden treasures you may purchase or use something you already own. With the guidance of Shawn Clifton, a degreed Interior Designer with over 25 years of experience, you will learn how to restore these items to their former glory or give them a new life. During the semester, a few projects may include: faux finishing, furniture painting, basic upholstery, creating/up-cycling a lamp.

**\*WATERCOLOR/ABSTRACT/NON-OBJECTIVE PAINTING** - in Watercolor, Abstract Painting, we will explore the use of watercolor combined with a variety of other substances. We will start class by creating an experimental/technique sheet. These experiments will then lead us to the exploration of abstraction in painting. Abstraction can mean many different things to different people, it will be interesting to see the interpretation that each artist creates in class. Supplies will range from \$40 to \$50 and will be discussed at the first class meeting.
