Prompt A: Reflect on the SBEF mission provided above. Describe your experiences in SBISD and/or within your community that have either supported that mission or how you may have benefitted from that mission. What have you learned and how has that affected you and your outlook of your future?

Prompt B: Reflect on your time as a SBISD student. Describe a challenging time or situation (in or out of school) that required a great deal of hard work and effort. What did you do and what was the outcome? You may want to include any lessons learned along the way that will help you succeed after graduation.

Scholarship funds may be used for tuition, fees, books, room and board or for other items required by your college or university. If you are selected to receive a scholarship, you will be provided with instructions and a disbursement form to claim your scholarship. In some cases, these funds may be considered by the Internal Revenue Service as taxable income. Please consult your tax advisor.
