The Camacho Foundation has generously offered the Seniors of Spring Branch ISD the opportunity to compete for the Second Chance Scholarship. This scholarship is for students who may have faced a slow start in high school, but have the drive to enhance their life through a higher education beyond high school. There will be four (4) \$1,500 awards given for two African American/Hispanic (2) boys and two African American/Hispanic (2) girls.

Eligibility:

1. Preference is given to students in the 2nd, 3rd, or 4th quarter; however, 1st quarter students may apply who financial need has not been met by the university. (1st quarter student are required to provide a copy of their college's financial aid award letter)
2. Applied and gained acceptance to a trade school, community college, or a four year college
3. Copy of the college financial aid award letter is recommended (not required)
4. Must be of African American/Hispanic decent (one biological parent from either group)
5. Must have completed the FAFSA
6. Must demonstrate financial need
7. Undocumented students are also eligible to apply

To Apply:

1. Submit application (in one envelope) with:
2. A 250-300 word personal statement
3. Unofficial Transcript
4. FAFSA Student Aid Report
5. Recommended, but not required, college acceptance letter

Deadline: **Tuesday, April 1, 2016 by 4:00 p.m.**

Notification:

If you are awarded, you will be notified by email, phone, and/or mail by May 6th. Once verification of enrollment to the college is made, scholarship will be sent directly to the college by August 1st.
